## **CLEANING & DISINFECTION OF iPADS**

For Patients with Suspect or Confirmed COVID-19

## **Read All Steps Prior to Removal:**


- iPads shall remain in their designated Otterbox cases for their entire time in use
- iPads remaining in patient rooms during admission should be included in HTC process by nursing during their shift
- iPads remaining in patient rooms during admission can be Bioquelled in room after patient discharge
- Coordinate with another HCW for hand-off process of clean iPad

## iPad Removal from Room: BEFORE all contact PPE has been doffed in room

- 1. Use an Oxivir wipe to clean and disinfect the iPad. Observe the 60 second wet time. Discard wipe when done.
- 2. Using new Oxivir wipe, open door.
- 3. Hand iPad to HCW who is outside of room and ready to receive iPad. HCW receiving iPad can when wipe iPad using Oxivir wipe for 60 second wet time.
- 4. Close door. Commence doffing PPE process per PPE checklist.

## **Rotation of iPads through Bioquell:**

• iPads that are cleaned and disinfected using the Oxivir process as above may also be Bioquelled on a regular basis. The schedule of Bioquelling will be dependent on the iPads in rotation, to be determined by the needs of the unit.
