## Transport of PUI/Covid+ Healthy Baby from L&D to MBU

L&D to notify MBU about potential patient coming while identified patient in labor.

MBU/NBN to look up as much info as possible on patient in PowerChart and CPN and pre-fill kardex.

L&D to call more detailed report to MBU/NBN RN once Mom stable.

## Scenario 1 (Separation)

- L&D to call NBN CN when Mom is completely dilated and beginning to push and provide any necessary details about labor process?
- Bring isolette to L&D from storage room on MBU
- Take two team members to transport infant; following transport of PUI/Covid guideline
- L&D RN to verify bands on baby with Mom, they will let MBU RN know that this was done
- L&D RN to place swaddled infant in isolette at doorway with cord bloods and bulb syringe
- MBU/NBN Team members to bring isolette to room 10 on MBU where primary RN in PPE ready to accept infant into open crib in room 10
- Team to ensure isolette is cleaned and placed back into storage room, available for next patient

## Scenario 2 (Rooming In)

- Report to be called to primary RN before transport and provide report on Mom and Baby
- Two L&D team members transport Mom to MBU Room 10; following transport of PUI/Covid guideline
- Mask on patient and support person
- Clean gown/clean sheet over patient
- L&D RN to call MBU unit secretary to let them know they are on the way
- MBU unit secretary to ensure hallway clear of other patients/visitors
- Primary RN with PPE in room 10 ready to accept patients
  - Bedside report given, kardex and papers stay outside of room

## Scenario 3 (OR 14)

- L&D to notify NBN CN that patient is being taken to OR for delivery and provide any necessary details about labor thus far?
- NBICU RN Supervisor will attend the delivery in OR 14. Due to donning and duffing procedure, the NBICU RN Supervisor will not be able to leave the OR following the delivery.
- A "clean" MBU RN will be allowed to take a transport isolette into the OR suite and have the isolette at the door of OR 14. The MBU RN will not have to have special surgical scrubs or don PPE with the exception of a bouffant and procedural/surgical mask.
- MBU/NBN RN and NBICU RN Sup to verify ID bands present and match Mom
- NBICU RN Sup to provide any relevant info from delivery to MBU/NBN RN
- The NBICU RN Supervisor will come to the door and place the swaddled baby into the waiting isolette with MBU/NBN nurse (two team members).
- Follow transport guideline of PUI/Covid patient to MBU room 10
