

SOM Dept/Division/Resident N95 Home Units (updated 10.8.2020)

Purpose: This list indicates the location for N95 mask retrieval based on service. Fit Testing can be done in these areas and also in the BATCAVE and in some academic departments as per the previous guidance. For upcoming after-hours, holiday, or weekend shifts, an N95 mask should be obtained from the service-based home unit in advance during regular business hours due to the fit testing resources that are more readily available at those times. As a reminder, the use of a procedure mask to cover the N95 is recommended in order to allow for extended use/re-use. ****This document is NOT applicable to the process of elastomeric or CAPR/PAPR distribution or fit testing.*
