



Download and install the zoom application using the following link. <https://zoom.us/download>

Click Sign In and then click Sign In with SSO



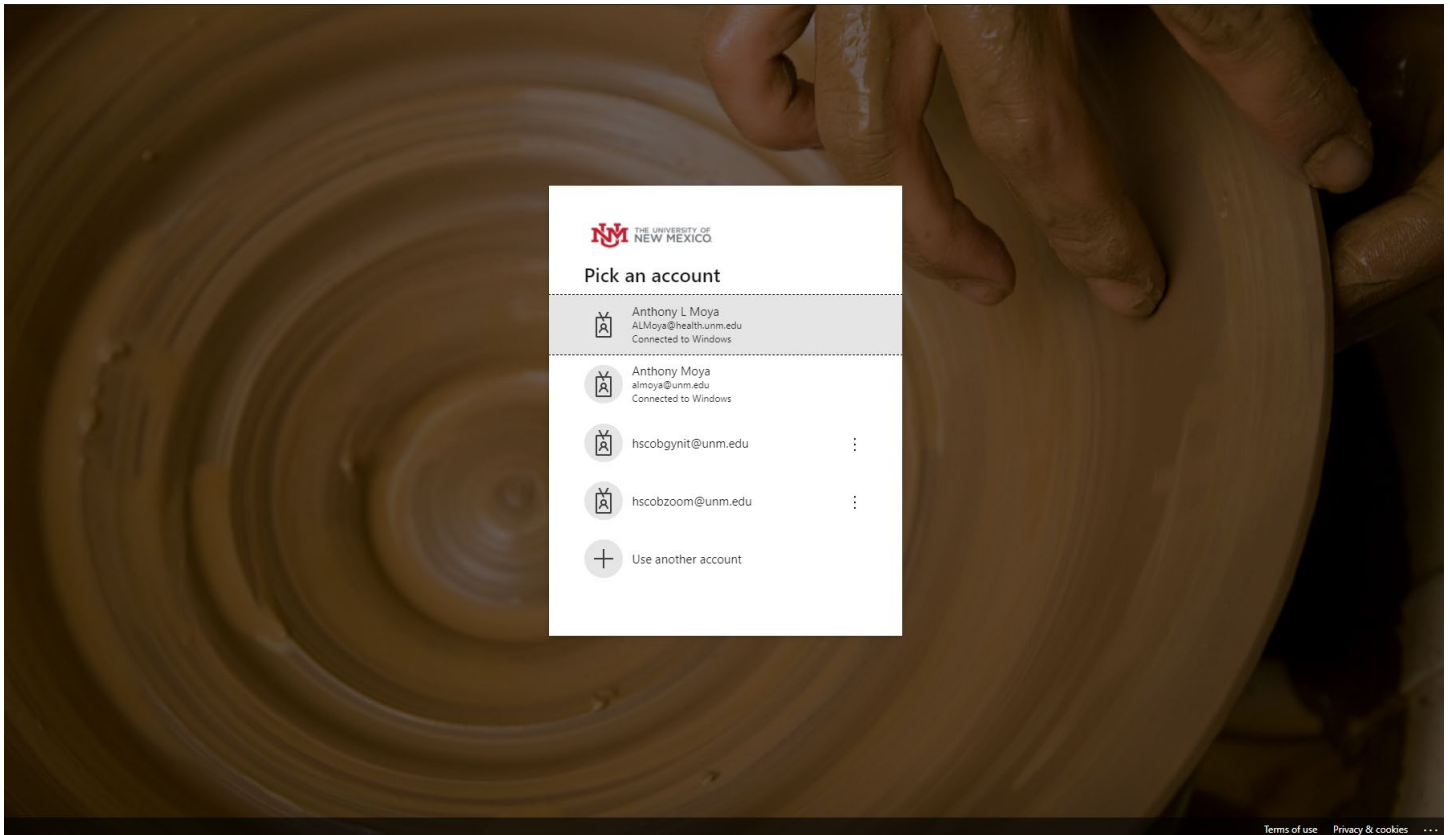

Type in UNM for the Company Domain and click Continue.

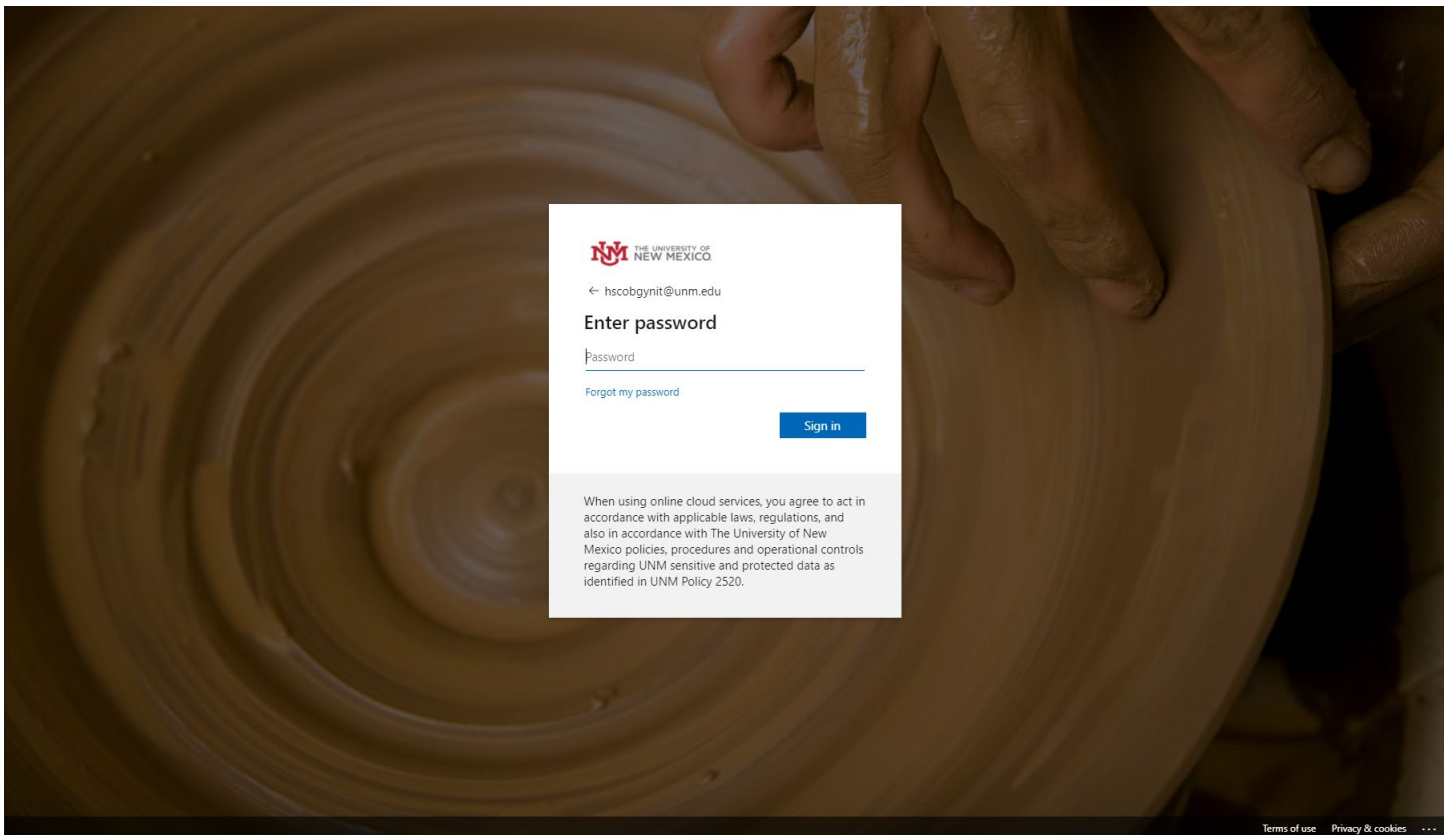


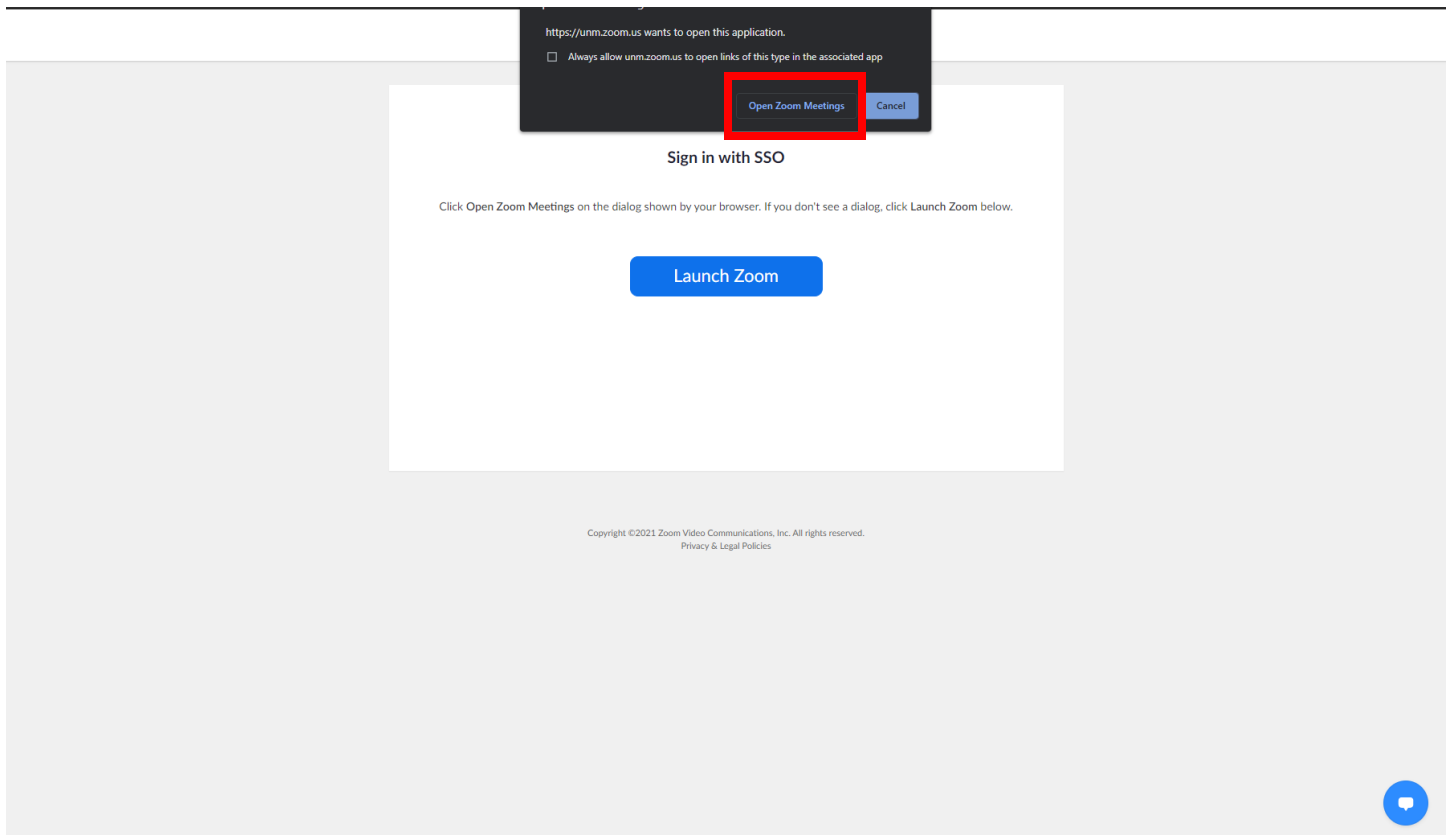
