All Services are on a sliding-scale or free for those with very limited financial resources. For embryonic/fetal remains and infants/children under age 2 residing locally, this includes transfer, dressing, service, viewing, graveside service, and casket. Cremation of infants over 500g need a cremation permit that costs approximately \$100.00. Costs do apply to upgrade certain items.

All Services are free for embryonic/fetal remains and infants/children under age 2, residing locally. Cost is \$500 for non-local families. Cremation after any signs of life, requires cremation permit of \$210.00 (required by state). This includes (cremation): a required 30 minute family visit, pick up from hospital, teddy bear urn, and cremation. This includes (burial): a required 60 minute family visit, pick up from hospital, family limo from funeral home to cemetery, casket and graveside service. Costs do apply to upgrade certain items (headstones, purchased through Sunset Cemetery, or urns).
