

# Medicine for miscarriage • • • •

Today you will take a pill (mifepristone) by mouth in clinic or in OB Triage





### 24 hours after taking the first pill



### Insert 4 pills (misoprostol) vaginally


- Insert pills the same way you would insert a tampon, towards the back of the vagina.
- Lie down for 30 minutes to make sure the medication will be absorbed.
- After 30 minutes if any of the pills fall out, it is OK. The medicine has already been absorbed in the body.



### After inserting the 4 pills vaginally


You may take pain medication for cramping.

- IBUPROFEN (Motrin), 3-4 pills, every 4-6 hours is the best for cramping pain
- If other pain medicine is needed, your provider may prescribe it



# In The Following Days:

If you have cramps, take ibuprofen as needed
