DESCRIPTION/OVERVIEW

Group paging allows simultaneous notification of stakeholders in emergency situations. The *OB-STAT Alert* emergency notification system is utilized for obstetric emergencies to notify Obstetrics, Family Medicine, Anesthesia, Charge Nurse, and the Scrub Tech of active emergencies involving parturients. This document summarizes how to activate the *OB-STAT Alert* Rapid Response Team group paging utilizing the UNM 333 emergency response system and Tiger Connect secure text Messaging system.

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

Labor and Delivery
OB Testing and Triage

PROCEDURE

1. *OB STAT Alert* Rapid Response Team Members will include all members of the L&D teams outlined in Attachment A
 - a. *NICU will require a separate page as they are not included on the 333 system.*
2. All messages will automatically go to Tiger Connect ! **OB STAT Alert** Broadcast in Tiger Connect
3. The following list of emergencies should result in the activation of the *OB STAT Alert* group:
 - a. *Emergent cesarean section*
 - b. *Life threatening maternal hemorrhage*
 - c. *Maternal respiratory failure*
 - d. *Non-terminating maternal seizures*
 - e. *Non-terminating shoulder dystocia*
4. To activate an *OB STAT Alert* via the phone the bedside nurse or their delegate should:
 - a. Dial **505-272-3333** or if calling from a hospital landline, dial **333**
 - b. Once connected with the 333 operator, state the following for a labor and delivery location:
 - i. "I would like to activate the "OB-STAT" for _____ (*emergent cesarean, maternal hemorrhage, maternal seizure, maternal respiratory*

failure). We are in BBRP 4th Floor Labor and Delivery room _____ going to OR _____.”

- c. From OB triage state the following:
“I would like to activate the “OB-STAT” for _____ (*emergent cesarean, maternal hemorrhage, maternal seizure, maternal respiratory failure*). We are in BBRP 4th Floor OB Triage room _____”
5. **To activate *OB STAT Alert*** directly via Tiger Connect the bedside nurse or their delegate should:
 - a. Open Tiger Connect Application on phone
 - b. Go to the “New message” icon
 - c. Type “OB STAT Alert” into search bar
 - d. Type broadcast message with required information as suggested in Attachment B
 - e. Hit send
6. **Maternal Cardiac Arrest** requires activating 2 response teams and must go through 333 as follows:
 - a. The bedside nurse or their delegate should dial: **505-272-3333** or if calling from a hospital landline, dial **333** and state the following:
 - i. “I would like to activate a “Maternal Code Blue”. We are in BBRP [location].”
 - b. The 333 operator will page out the following message to the *OB-STAT Alert* team for a maternal code:
 - i. OB STAT: Maternal Code [Location]
 - c. 333 should *first* activate the UNM Code Team (Dr. Heart)
 - d. 333 should also activate the “OB-STAT” Team
7. Receiving an *OB STAT Alert* Message
 - a. Upon receiving an *OB STAT Alert* message, all members of the rapid response team should respond immediately to the indicated location on the page to begin administering emergency aid
 - b. Additional persons may be called as needed and as determined by attending physician

ATTACHMENT B: OB STAT Alert suggested text

The 333 operator will page the following messages for emergency notification:

- STAT Cesarean Section
 - **OB STAT: CS (*Location*) going to (*Location*)**
i.e. “**OB STAT: CS Labor Room 1 going to OR 15**”
- Maternal Hemorrhage
 - **OB STAT: BLEED (*Location*)) going to (*Location*)**
- Maternal Respiratory Failure
 - **OB STAT: Resp Failure (*Location*)**
- Maternal Non Self Limiting Seizure
 - **OB STAT: Seizure (*Location*)**
 - *Note:* Seizure may be written SZ
- Maternal Cardiac Arrest
 - **OB STAT: Maternal Code (*Location*)**
- Other
 - **OB STAT: Rapid Response (*Location*)**
