

Perinatal Steering Committee Charter

Purpose

The purpose of the Perinatal Steering Committee (Committee) of the University of New Mexico Hospital (UNMH) is to provide collective oversight and review of issues including standardization of processes, medical standards, quality assurance, research, ancillary services involvement, and policies related to the inpatient Women's Services areas while advancing the mission of UNMH. The Committee serves as the governing body for Women's Services area protocols and procedures in the inpatient setting and as the operations hub for the alignment of strategic initiatives across inpatient units.

Decision Making

- At all meetings the presence of a majority of the voting members shall be necessary and sufficient to constitute a quorum.
- Except as otherwise provided by law, the act of a majority of the voting members present at a meeting at which there is a quorum shall be the act of the Committee.

- Acts of the Committee shall not supersede UNMH Policies and/or UNMH Medical Staff Bylaws.
- Any decisions or acts considered by the Committee that extend beyond inpatient Women's Services shall be undertaken in collaboration with UNMH leadership.

Meetings

• The Perinatal Steering Committee shall meet monthly or as needed, at least 10 times per year.

Committee Responsibilities

The Committee shall have the responsibility to:

- Consult with, review, and advise management and make recommendations as to the UNMH inpatient Women's Services areas clinical operations related to standardization of processes, medical standards, quality assurance, research, ancillary services involvement, and policies, and, to the extent necessary or required, monitor corrective actions undertaken to bring UNMH into compliance with any legal, operations, or clinical requirements.
- Provide oversight of the care provided in UNMH inpatient Women's Services areas including through regular review of quality reporting and review and approval of clinical guidelines and policies.
